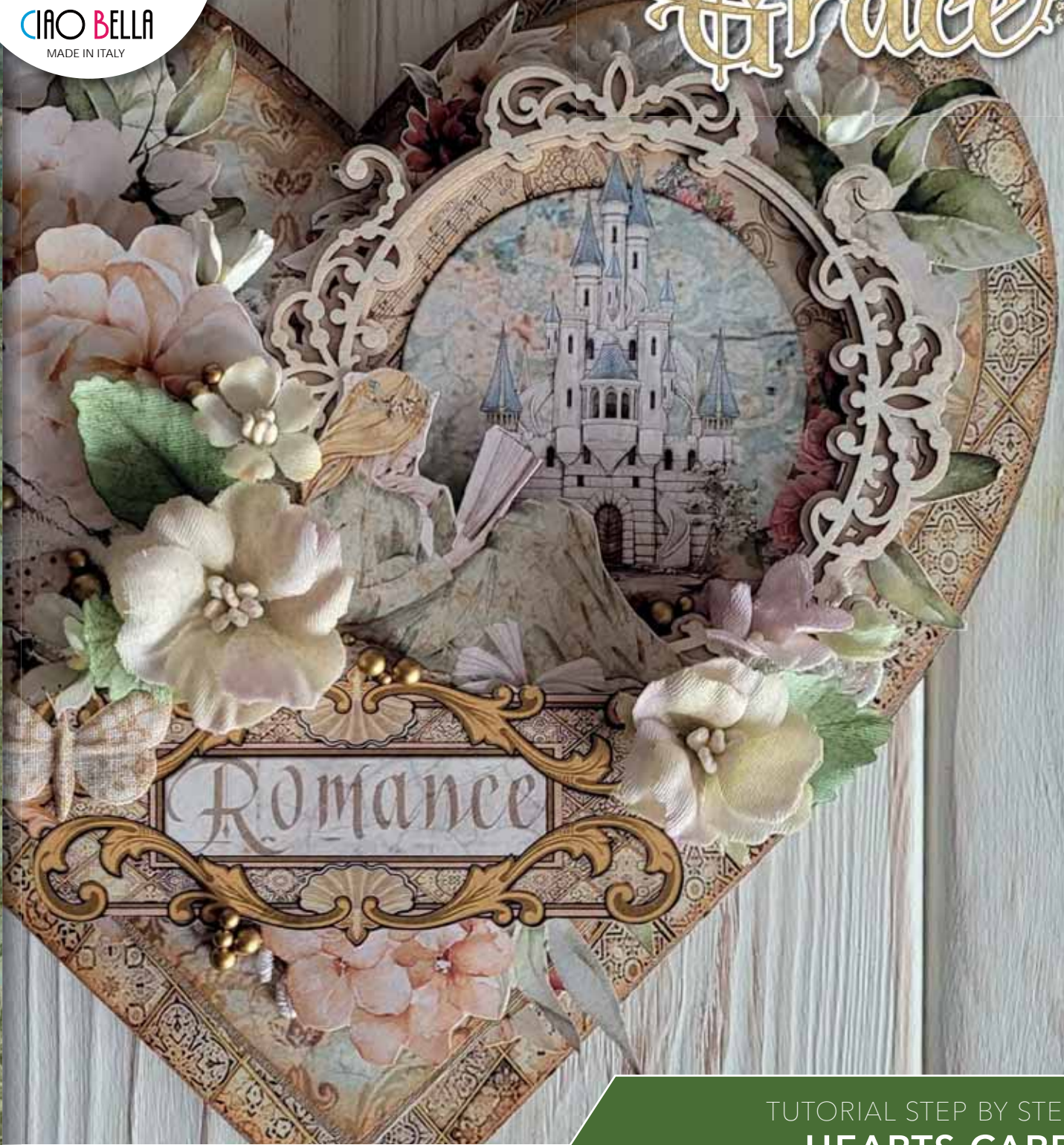

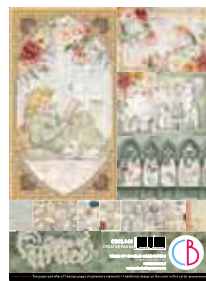

# LONDON ALBUM

## MATERIALS

- Paper Pad 30x30
- Creative pad A4
- Fussy Pad 15x15
- 5 A4 kraft cardboard
- Glue for paper and cardboard

### Embellishments:

- Lace
- Clipboard
- Flowers of fabric or paper
- Toppings

Cut 4 hearts of kraft cardboard in different sizes (a bigger heart for the base; the other three must be smaller than the previous, creating a scale; measures by choice).

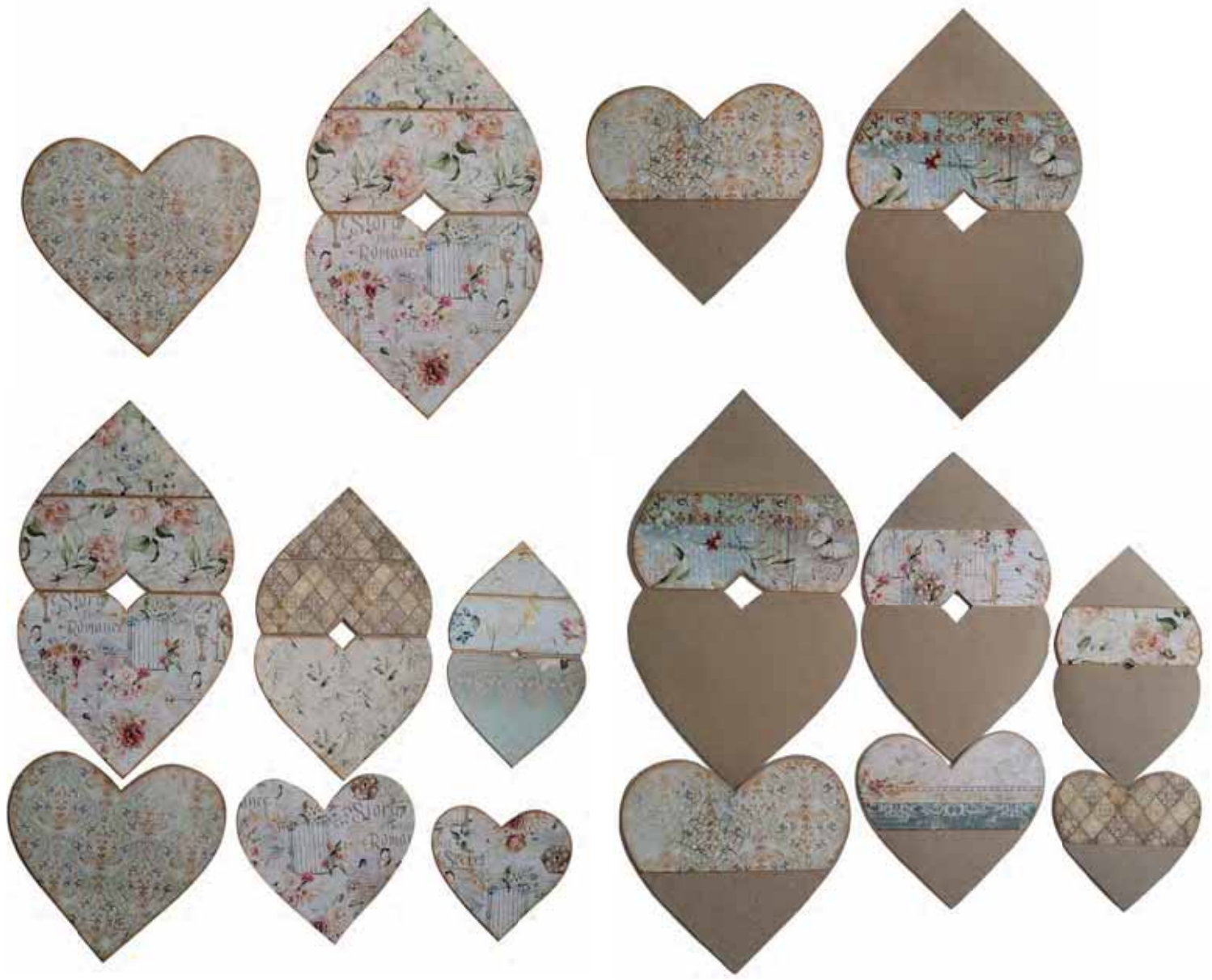
In order to create the other three hearts, cut 3 cards with heart shape as in picture: take a cardboard and do the binding in the middle. Draw the shape of the heart, leaving 1 cm in the upper part for the binding. Cut it: in this way you'll have three heart-shaped cards that can be opened. Do an horizontal binding in the middle of upper part of these cards.

Stick the scrapbooking paper on the kraft base as in pictures.





**3** Stick together each heart with the correspondent base card; glue the triangular parts without paper. In this way, create three heart shaped cards that can be positioned vertically.

Stick all the hearts together. The bigger heart is the base. Stick one heart over the other from the smaller to the bigger. When the card is closed, the bigger heart remains above the others. When the card is open, the smaller heart is on the front part, the bigger on the back.

In the horizontal part of the heart stick a decorative element (in this case a heart shaped button) which will be used to fix the position of the smaller heart when the card is open. The other two heart will be fixed by the back part of the front hearts.

Decorate the three hearts with the fussy cut elements, lace, clipboard, and flowers. Check that the embellishment elements allow the correct position of the elements when is closed.
