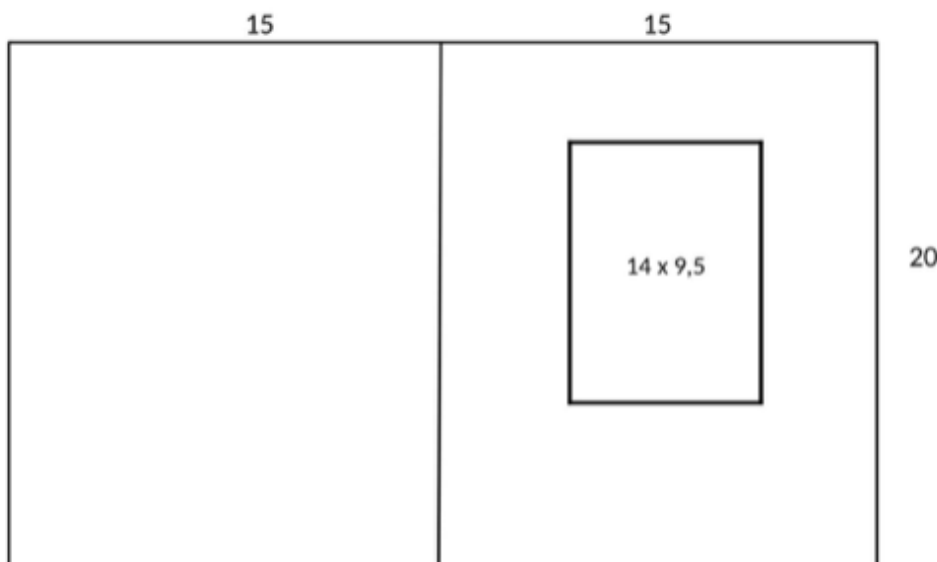

ADVENT CALENDAR

MATERIALS

- 1 Paper Pad CBPM057
- 1 Fussy Cutting Pad CBQE057
- Ivory cardboard 30x30cm, 200 gr
- Paper glue
- Tissue paper A4 sizes
- Acetate paper A5 sizes
- Toppings, glitter to fill the shaker
- Cardboard 10x20 cm, 1 mm
- Double sided adhesive spacers



1

Cut the cardboard for the base of the card as indicate: 20x30 cm with binding in the middle (15cm). Cut a window in the middle of the front part of the card of 14x9.5 cm.

Cut 4 rectangles 19.8x14.8 of the scrapbooking card and cut the windows (you'll find the window draw in Paper Pad cover)





2 Glue the scrapbooking card on the cardboard base.

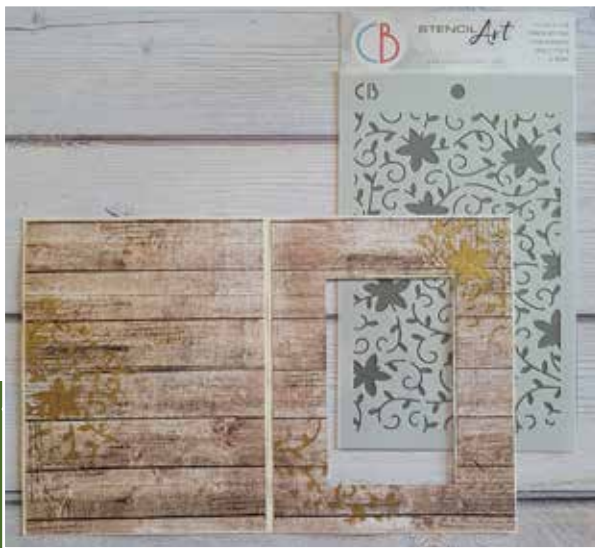

Create the shaker. Cut a rectangle of acetate 0.5 bigger than the window hole on each side (14.5x10). Paste it in the rear part of the window cut from the scrapbooking paper. Prepare the shaker's edges creating a frame.



Do the edges with the cardboard 1 mm (you can choose even thicker cardboard). It is very important not to leave any space otherwise you'll risk losing the shaker's filling. Insert the topping. Cut a rectangle of tissue paper to close the shaker and stick it.



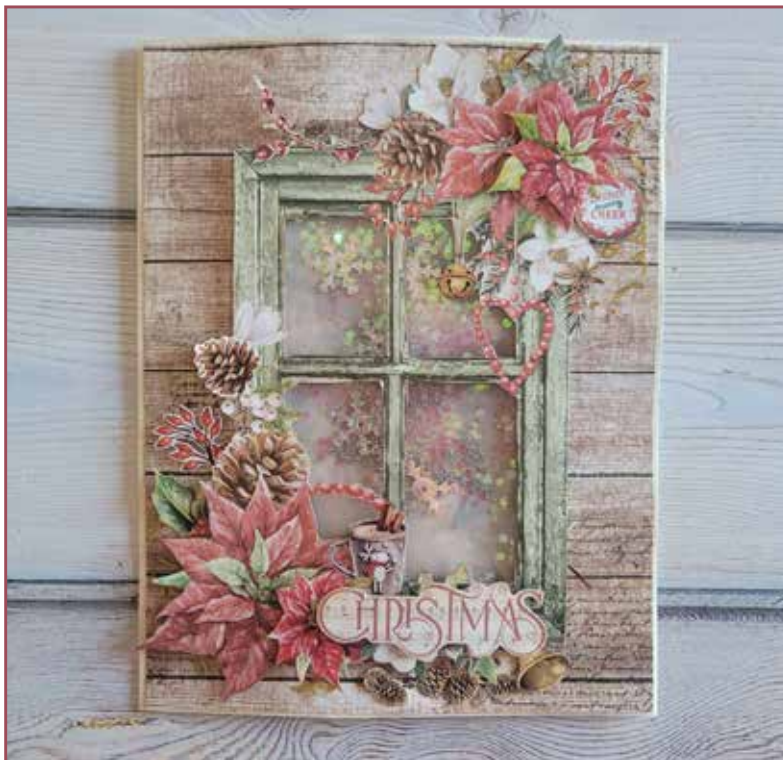

Decorate the outer part of the card using stamps or stencils by choosing.

Paste the shaker on the card. In the inner part decorate the edges with a frame of scrapbooking paper (14.7x10.2 cm, 1 side 1 cm of wight)

Decorate the little window on the front face with fussy cut element (15x15 cutting pad) using double sided adhesive spacers.

If in the inner part you use the paper that don't allow you to write a message, you can paste one of the cards already printed in the Paper Pad.
