



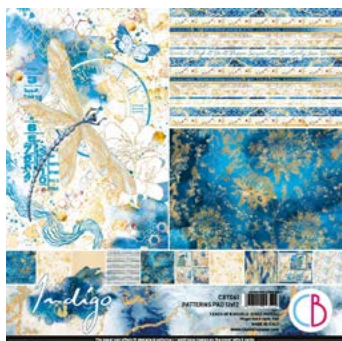

INDIGO ALBUM

MATERIALS

- Kit Binding Album KSV026
- Kit Binding Album KSA01
- Paper Pad 30x30 Indigo
- Patterns Pad 30x30 Indigo
- 20x20 Pad Indigo
- Fussy cut 15x15 Pad Indigo
- A4 Creative pad Indigo
- 5 Kraft cardboard 30x30 cm
- White chalk
- Golden and copper acrylic colors
- Stencils MS022, MS034
- Texture glitter gel
- Glue for cardboard and paper
- 2 m Cotton or silk ribbon in blue, gold, and yellow
- 16 magnets 8x1 mm
- 10 eyelets
- Embellishments by choice: chipboards, lace, paper flowers, fabric...

Cover the carved paper with white chalk. Refine the edges of the pages with golden acrylic color. Use two carved pages and 5 shaped pages (one of both will be the cover) to create the album.

Paint the carved pages with golden acrylic paint and refine the edges with the copper color. If needed fix it with the crackle past (not compulsory).



3 Decorate the outer parts using stencils (MS022, MS034) and glitter gel.



4 Cut the scrapbooking paper to create the pages. The diameter of the album is 22 cm, so cut the paper a little smaller, about 19.8 cm x 10 circles. Glue the paper on the base of the album. To create the cover, use a shaped page and a carved page. Paste the paper on the shaped page, then glue the carved page on it.



5 Cut the elements to embellish the album. Use the kraft cardboard as a base for your pictures. Cut 10 circles of 14 cm of diameter and 12 circles of 10 cm of diameter: make use of these to glue the pictures. As decorations and lock with magnets, cut circles of 6.5 cm, 5 cm, 4 cm and 3.5 cm. Cut the scrapbooking paper:

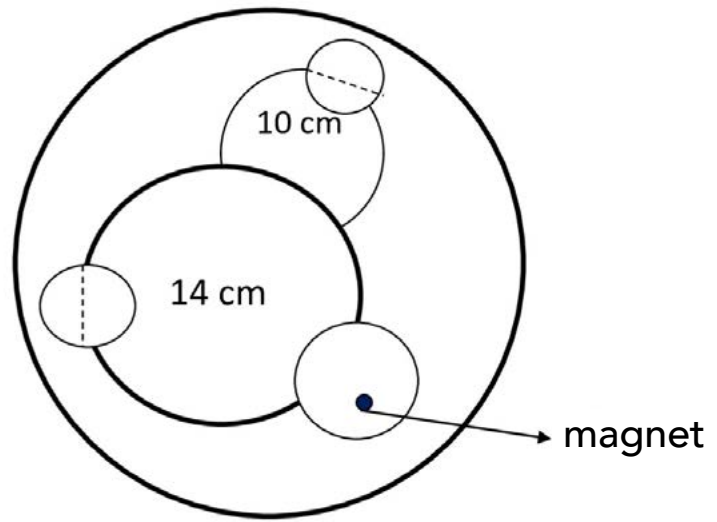
- 18 circles of scrapbooking paper of 13.8 cm diameter for the 10 circles of 14 cm (8 will be glued back and front + 2 only front).
- 24 circles of scrapbooking paper of 9.8 cm diameter for the 12 circles of 10 cm (they will be all glued back and front).



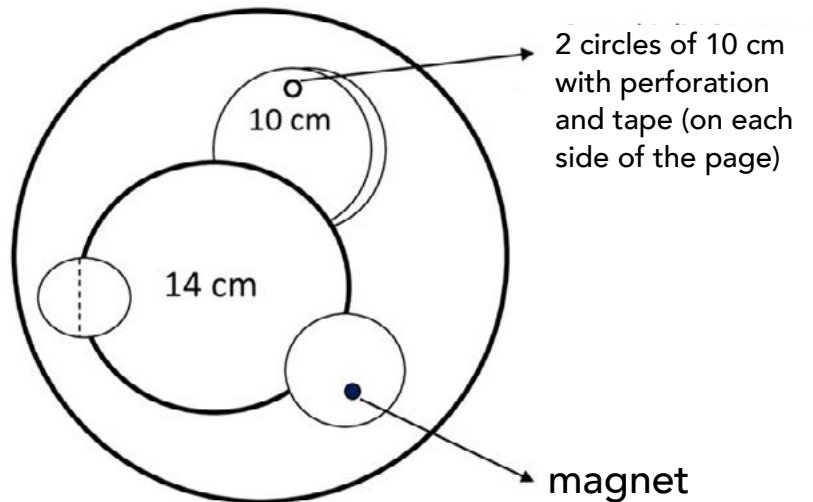

Decorate the pages following two different patterns:

PATTERN 1: On the page, glue 1 circles of 10 cm diameter and 1 circle of 14 cm diameter, no matter the position. Use little circles of 4.5/5 cm of kraft cardboard, with central binding, to glue the previous bigger circles to the page. As a lock, use a magnet pasted on the other circle of 5 cm joint with the circle of 14 cm and another magnet glued of the main page of 22 cm (pattern 1)



PATTERN 2: On the page, glue only one circle of 14 cm of diameter. Pierce the main page and 2 little circles of 10 cm diameter + other 2 little circles for the other part of the page; insert the eyelets and join everything using the ribbon. To glue the circle of 14 cm to the page, use little kraft circle of 4.5/5 cm with binding in the middle. As a lock, use the magnet of the circle of 5 cm joint with the one of 14 cm and another magnet on the main page of 22 cm. (pattern 2)





Use these two patterns for all the pages, varying the position of the circles.
For the carved page, use only one circle of 14 cm for each side + decorations



7 Join all the pages of the album with ribbons of various material (cotton, silk or lace). Embellish the pages by choice, using little lace, chipboard and elements from the 15x15 fussy cut pad and the A4 creative pad.
