



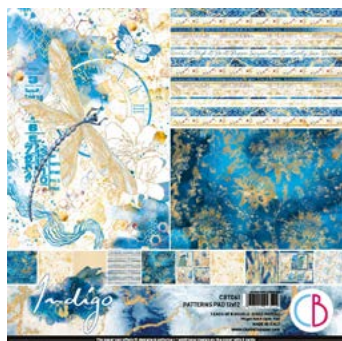

INDIGO FAN-SHAPED CARD

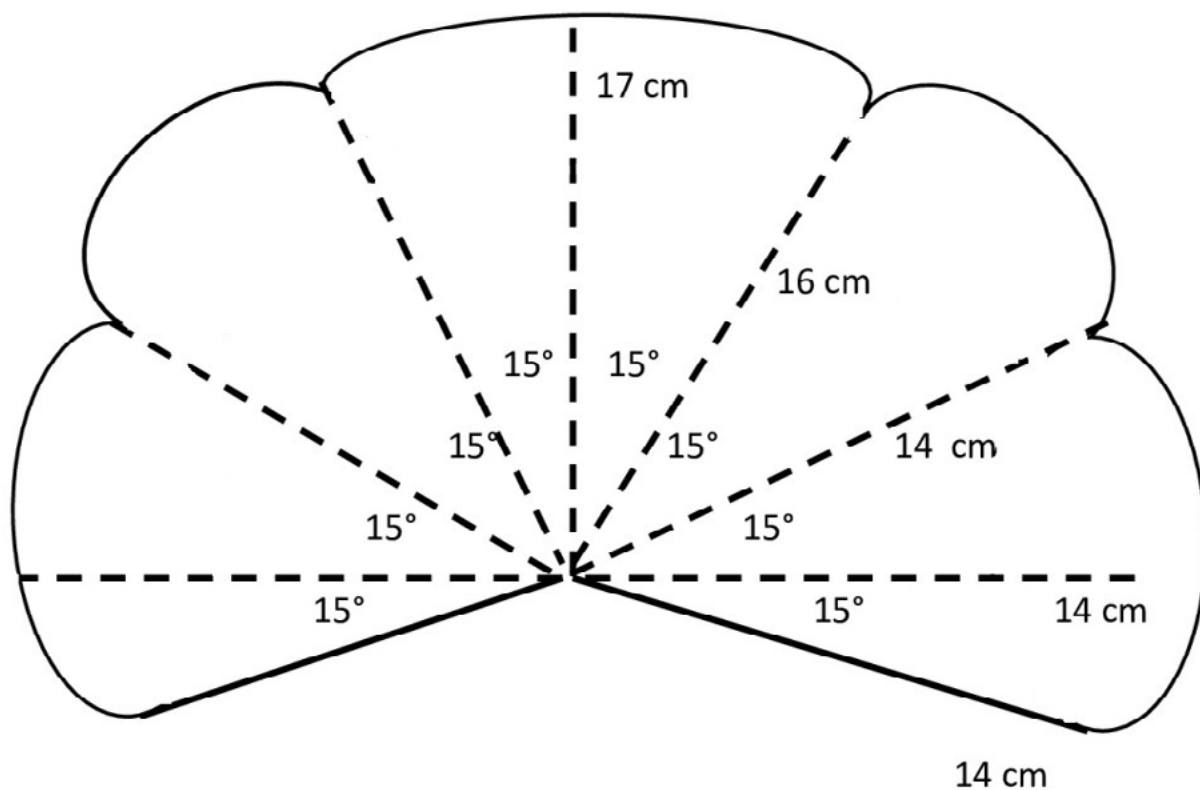
MATERIALS

- Any size of Paper Pad 30x30;
Patterns Pad 30x30;
Pad 20x20 Indigo
- 1 kraft cardboard 30x30
- Fussy cut pad 15x15 Indigo
- Glue for paper
- 4 magnets
- Embellishment by choice: lace,
chipboard ecc.

*Option: stamps from Indigo
collection, stamp PS8010, heat
embossing with golden powder*

Using kraft cardboard 30x30 prepare the base for the card as in the scheme, cut and do the binding.





2 Cut 16 triangles (back/front) of scrapbooking paper, they will be glued on the base. Each triangle has an angle of 15° : use one as a model, only changing the length of each side and the round upper part. Now, paste them only on one side of the base.



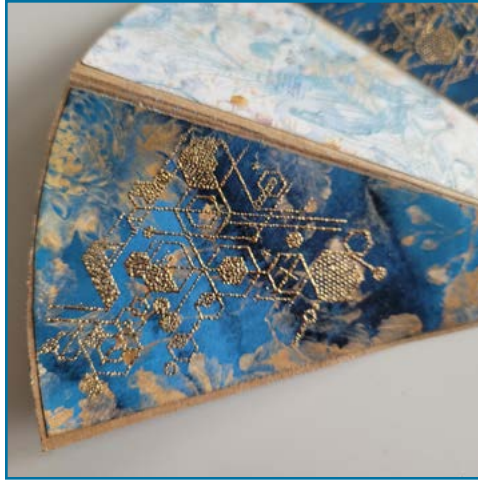
3 Create a little diamond (with an angle of 30° , sides of 7 cm, 7 cm, 5 cm and 5 cm length) that will contain the card using the following scheme:

Decorate the card using the stamps from Indigo collection and heat embossing it with the golden powder.





5 Glue the diamond, paste the scrapbooking paper on it and arrange the magnets. Put the magnet even in the card and paste the scrapbooking paper on it.

Decorate the composition with fussy cut elements.
Be sure to sure tiny decorations, otherwise it won't close properly.
Bigger embellishment can be used on the little diamond.
Magnets will fix the diamond when the card is open.
